As part of our Science work in term 6, Sri Lanka class will be studying the topic of 'forces'. It is primarily focused upon identifying the forces which occur when an object moves.

As an educational treat, we are planning on going on a trip to the National Space Centre, in Leicester, on Monday 10th June.

The total cost of the trip is £15.60. This includes coach travel, entry fee to the Space Centre and a live show.
